




2. Under **Tacho4Safe** you will find the latest firmware update, which you can download by clicking the **Download** link.



Go to your Downloads folder and locate the updateTacho4Safe.exe file.

Copy the file into the main folder of your Tacho4Safe device.




4. Open the newly copied updateTacho4Safe.exe file, in order to check if the firmware on your device is up to date.


If the firmware is outdated, the setup wizard will download the required files and copy them to the "Update" folder of the device.

After the setup is finished, you can go ahead and click the **Close** button and proceed to step **7** of this guide.


If your firmware version is up to date, then no additional files will be installed. After the setup is finished, you can go ahead and click the **Close** button and proceed to step **10** of this guide.

Check to see if the required files are in the "Update" folder of the device.

- Remove the USB cable from the device, then wait until all lights are off.
- Plug the USB cable back into the device, then wait for the update process to start. If the update is successful, the device will beep shortly and will be displayed as a USB mass storage device afterwards.
- Navigate to the main folder of the device and open the Firmware_version.txt and version.txt files.

Compare them to see if your device is up to date.
